SUBJECT: FY 2019-20 O&M Budget Update and Proposed Budget Amendments

Summary/Discussion

In this past fiscal year there have been two statewide disaster declarations (Covid-19 Pandemic and Civil Unrest), one locally declared emergency (Laguna Beach North Coast Interceptor sewer spill), and one Agency declared emergency (Effluent Transmission Main (ETM) sewer spill) during this Fiscal Year. The COVID-19 pandemic is affecting major economic and financial markets, and virtually all industries and government agencies are facing challenges associated with the economic efforts to address it.

Throughout the pandemic response SOCWA has tracked the COVID-19 related expenditures for the purpose of submission to FEMA in the amount of \$79,000. Staff can report that despite these expenses, the total O&M budget will not be exceeded.

In May 2020, the Board approved several Project Committee budget adjustments, including (i) PC 2 \$50,000¹, PC 12 \$35,000², PC 21 \$100,000³, PC 23 \$30,000⁴. These additions are reflected in the YTD financials report as a part of the Adjusted Budget information.

As reported to the Finance Committee at its June 23, 2020 meeting, for the projected close of the fiscal year (May and June 2020) it appears that PC 5 will come in over budget by \$60,000 in costs related to support of the Junction Structure Project and increases in permit fees, among other items⁵.

Additionally, for PC 2 Operations Expenses totaling approximately \$140,000 have been identified as over budget in the final quarter of the FY. Staff will provide an update on costs at the Board meeting for PC 2.

In addition, for purpose of completing the expenditure of the PC 21 funding approved as noted in May 2020, staff intends to recommend with the FY 2019-2020 Use Audit a carry forward of approved funding to complete the pipeline repair and response.

For purposes of closing the fiscal year with budget approvals consistent with year-end expenditures, the staff recommends:

- 1. PC 5 to approve a FY 2019-2020 Budget Adjustment of \$60,000.
- 2. PC 2 to approve a FY 2019-2020 Budget Adjustement of \$140,000 (with possible revision at the Board meeting based on final bills coming in).

Staff notes that there will not be an exceedance of the total O&M Budget and refunds from other PCs due to the member agencies will net out the additional expense(s) in the final Use Audit.
