Basic Concept

FIRST SEVEN YEARS

- SOCWA will continue to own the JBL, Coastal, and Regional Treatment Plants through 2030
- SOCWA will continue to operate the treatment plants through 2030, with the exception of the following:
 - RTP will be operated by MNWD starting in est. 2024
 - Latham Secondary Plant will be operated by SCWD once SMWD's proposed DPR facility is operational

AFTER 7 YEARS


- SCWD to own & operate Latham Secondary Plant
 - SMWD and MNWD to retain capacity interest
- SMWD to own & operate Latham Advanced Water Treatment
- MNWD to own & operate Regional Plant
- SCWD, City of Laguna Beach and Emerald Bay will own Coastal Plant, with future operations being determined in first 7 years

Latham Plant

- SCWD to assume operation of secondary plant when downstream SMWD advanced water treatment facility is operational & for beneficial reuse <u>or</u> within seven years, whichever is first
 - SCWD to own facility, SMWD and MNWD have capacity rights
 - Water quality guarantee for secondary effluent
- SMWD to plan, design, construct, and operate a facility to treat the secondary effluent for advanced water treatment under proposed SWRCB regulations
- Extend the PC 2 Agreement to allow time for development of new agreements, to March 31, 2024
- Cooperate on location of new facility on or adjacent to Latham site
 - Lease or easement to SMWD for site



Coastal Plant

- SCWD, CLB and EBCSD collaborate on future operation of the plant
- Develop a "buyout" agreement with MNWD, in order to "right-size" the future capacity
- New operator or new agreement in place no later than seven-years
